What we've been up to!

General Information

We are now in the 28th year of servicing the most needy in our community.

The fund has provided assistance in a variety of ways including support with food through our food pantry, assistance with heat and heating appliances throughout the winter and with medical assistance either directly or indirectly through HHHN or North Warren Central Schools.

Since our last newsletter we distributed more than \$33,000 of assistance in the following ways:

General Assistance

- Provided a Ranai heater to a senior citizen to replace a 1920's cook stove used to provide heat, to her cabin
- Paid for diagnostics for a furnace that was not working
- Helped to pay for the installation of electricity to a

- senior citizen's home to remove a safety hazard
- Purchased personal hygiene items for individuals that might not have otherwise had access to supplies
- Purchased car insurance for an individual that had lost their job and required assistance
- Paid for eyeglasses and eye exams for two young North Warren students who had difficulty reading
- Repaired an automobile
- Provided funding for the Fall North Warren "Healthy Smiles" dental clinic for 30 students
- Had heating fuel delivered to 6 individuals requiring assistance
- We continued our "partnership" with Hudson Headwaters Health Network by providing financial assistance to qualified individuals and families for medical visits, dental procedures and medically necessary materials. This assistance was provided to people in Chestertown, Pottersville, Brant Lake and Schroon Lake
- Provided funding for prescription reimbursement for eligible individuals utilizing HHHN

Food Pantry

- Provided nutrition through our semi-monthly food pantry. This service was provided to 35 families in both Chestertown and Pottersville
- The Fund provided the essentials for holiday meals to an average of 40 families for during the Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter seasons.

 Provided special TOPS cards to folks who utilize the food pantry which will allow them to purchase either turkeys, hams or chickens for their holiday meals Issue

- Shared more than \$3800 in TOPS cards with clients of the Food Pantry, to be used for the purchase of food and household goods not provided in the food pantry
- Purchased and provided more than \$400 in TOPS cards to assist people requiring immediate assistance with food that were not regular users of the Food Pantry
